## A Letter from Our Pastor

Dear family and friends of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (SEAS):

### WHAT DO WE GET YOU?

That's the question I have been getting from several people: "What do we get you for your installation as our new pastor next week?" Well, please know that I already have plenty of religious articles, artwork, and more than enough books that are still unread! But, I've figured out that there are **TWO PERFECT GIFTS** that will surely put a smile on my face:

First gift suggestion: If you've not already done so, **make a pledge or increase your pledge to our HONORING our PAST, EMBRACING our FUTURE Capital Campaign!** How will this benefit me personally, you may ask? Well, new or increased pledges will definitely give me less grey hairs to the little I have left! I can't wait for the time when I don't have to beg people to get on board and support our future. Frankly, even though I've only been here two months, I'm feeling like a failure in not being able to inspire more people to embrace this campaign for us now and for generations to come (almost 90% have not participated yet!). So, pledging in any amount is better than no pledging at all, and it would be a great gift to your new pastor!

Second gift suggestion: **prayerfully consider increasing your weekly Sunday collection amount.** It's no secret that our weekly collection has been down for some time. The recent change in clergy assignments hasn't seen any increase in our Sunday offerings, as some were predicting. We have a goal of \$45,000 each week for our regular first collection. Last week we were nearly \$10,000 short of that weekly goal, and in these first two months of this new fiscal year (beginning in July) we're already almost \$62,000 behind what was budgeted! We simply can't continue in this direction.

I believe when someone sees a five-figure collection, they think we're rolling in the dough! Well, our monthly bills are in the five-figure range as well, and none of that is foolish spending! An additional increase in your weekly sacrificial offerings would help us move toward where we should be. Can I ask you to please do the math and see if your

weekly giving is on par with the concept of Christian Stewardship which states that 5% of your annual income should be given to your spiritual home? If you can't make the 5% mark, can you work your way up to it? Any increase would help us out tremendously!

So, how will an increase in your weekly giving help me personally? Well, it will help me worry less about paying our necessary bills and allow me to focus on more essential spiritual and pastoral matters for the good of us all. Also, increasing your weekly giving so we could meet our first collection goal would eliminate me having to beg for more. That would be another great gift to your new pastor!

In closing, I hope you're happy, or at least content, with my ministry among you so far. I also hope that you'll consider one or both of the above gifts to celebrate my beginning pastorate among you and this new chapter in the life of our great community of faith (and a win-win situation for us all)!

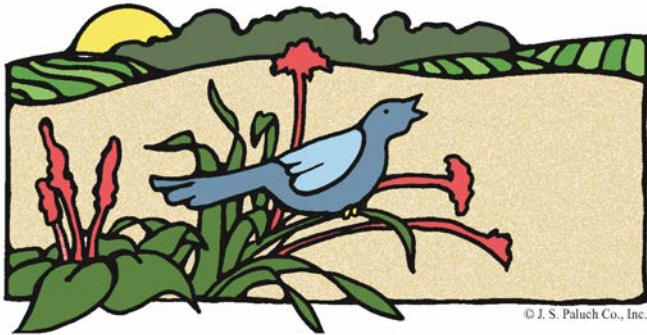

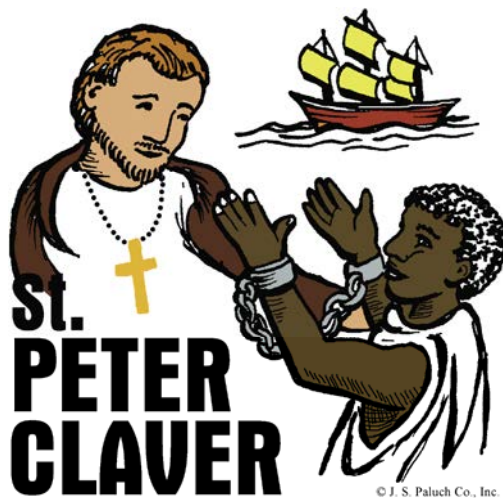
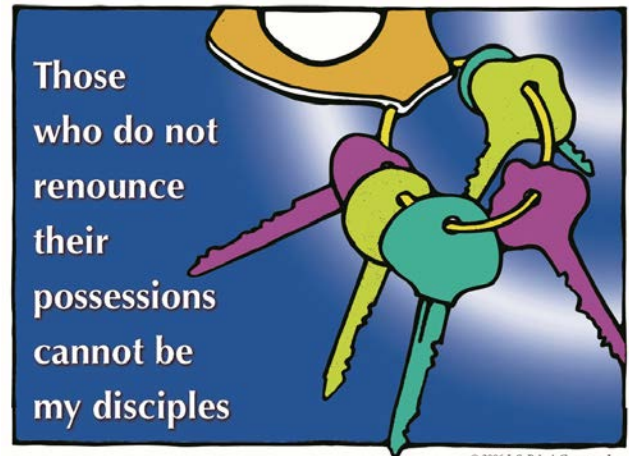
**Mental Health & Wellness Group**

### Saint of the Week

**Saint Peter Claver**  
1580 - 1654  
Memorial - September 9

Born in Spain, Peter was educated by Jesuits. He joined a Jesuit mission to the New World and arrived in what is now Colombia in 1610. He was ordained there and began a life-long ministry among African slaves. Peter felt it best to show by action the Christian spirit, so he brought the slaves food, medicine, and tobacco. Later, he would convey with drawings that they were loved by God even though they were abused by man. He was said to have baptized more than 300,000 and is patron of missionary work among blacks.

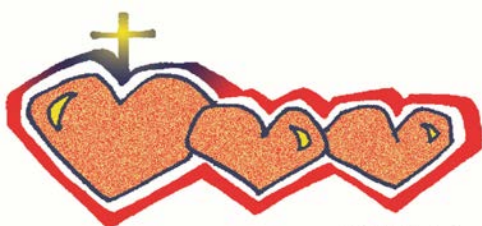

# Children's Faith Formation (age 3 – grade 8)

We offer formation classes for children preparing for First Eucharist, Baptism (older than age 7), Continuing Formation (after receiving the sacraments), and the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program for children ages 3 to 5 (entering kindergarten).

**The 2019-2020 season starts the week of September 17.**

**Classes:** Tuesdays and Thursdays

**Times:** 4:30 p.m. to 5:40 p.m.  
and 6:00 p.m. to 7:10 p.m.

### Requirements:

- Parents or guardians are registered members of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish or a Catholic Parish in the Las Vegas Diocese. Regular attendance at Sunday Liturgy is part of the formation process.
- Registration fee is \$150.00 per child. No child will be turned away due to financial difficulty.
- Families must provide a Birth and Baptism Certificate and deposit at the time of registration. Sacrament preparation at SEAS is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and the parent throughout the formation years.

### Sacraments:

#### Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC)

This is a two-year process for children who were not baptized as infants, who have attained the age of reason (7 years), are of catechetical age, and who will participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation at the Easter Vigil in their second year of preparation.

#### First Eucharist Initiation:

The two-year preparation process to celebrate First Eucharist teaches children about the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The child and the parent will participate in retreats in their second year.

#### Continuing Formation:

Children in 3rd grade and higher who are baptized and have received First Eucharist will continue their formation in age appropriate classes. It is the practice of our faith that formation is ongoing and is a life-long journey.

#### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS):

This is a hands-on, interactive working environment where children are guided toward a greater understanding of God's love in their life. They encounter Jesus the Good Shepherd, who loves them, cares for them and knows them by name. Children are most sensitive to a relationship with God between the ages of 3-6. For this reason, we provide formal faith formation for young children.

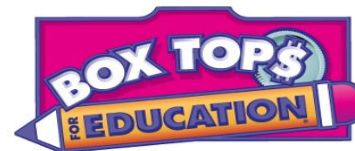

### Bible Study on The Book of Exodus

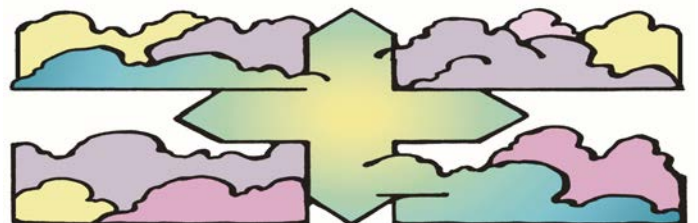

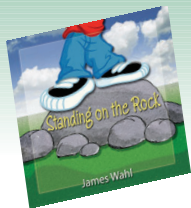

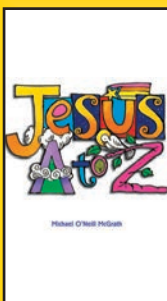
