

# A Letter from Our Pastor

Dear family and friends of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (SEAS):

#### WHAT DO WE GET YOU?

That's the question I have been getting from several people: "What do we get you for your installation as our new pastor next week?" Well, please know that I already have plenty of religious articles, artwork, and more than enough books that are still unread! But, I've figured out that there are **TWO PERFECT GIFTS** that will surely put a smile on my face:

First gift suggestion: If you've not already done so, make a pledge or increase your pledge to our HONORING our PAST, EMBRACING our FUTURE Capital Campaign! How will this benefit me personally, you may ask? Well, new or increased pledges will definitely give me less grey hairs to the little I have left! I can't wait for the time when I don't have to beg people to get on board and support our future. Frankly, even though I've only been here two months, I'm feeling like a failure in not being able to inspire more people to embrace this campaign for us now and for generations to come (almost 90% have not participated yet!). So, pledging in any amount is better than no pledging at all, and it would be a great gift to your new pastor!

Second gift suggestion: prayerfully consider increasing your weekly Sunday collection amount. It's no secret that our weekly collection has been down for some time. The recent change in clergy assignments hasn't seen any increase in our Sunday offerings, as some were predicting. We have a goal of \$45,000 each week for our regular first collection. Last week we were nearly \$10,000 short of that weekly goal, and in these first two months of this new fiscal year (beginning in July) we're already almost \$62,000 behind what was budgeted! We simply can't continue in this direction.

I believe when someone sees a five-figure collection, they think we're rolling in the dough! Well, our monthly bills are in the five-figure range as well, and none of that is foolish spending! An additional increase in your weekly sacrificial offerings would help us move toward where we should be. Can I ask you to please do the math and see if your

weekly giving is on par with the concept of Christian Stewardship which states that 5% of your annual income should be given to your spiritual home? If you can't make the 5% mark, can you work your way up to it? Any increase would help us out tremendously!

So, how will an increase in your weekly giving help me personally? Well, it will help me worry less about paying our necessary bills and allow me to focus on more essential spiritual and pastoral matters for the good of us all. Also, increasing your weekly giving so we could meet our first collection goal would eliminate me having to beg for more. That would be another great gift to your new pastor!

In closing, I hope you're happy, or at least content, with my ministry among you so far. I also hope that you'll consider one or both of the above gifts to celebrate my beginning pastorate among you and this new chapter in the life of our great community of faith (and a win-win situation for us all)!








#### Saint of the Week

Saint Peter Claver 1580 - 1654 Memorial - September 9

Born in Spain, Peter was educated by Jesuits. He joined a Jesuit mission to the New World and arrived in what is now Colombia in 1610. He was ordained there and began a life-long ministry among African slaves. Peter felt it best to show by action the Christian spirit, so he brought the slaves food, medicine, and tobacco. Later, he would convey with drawings that they were loved by God even though they were abused by man. He was said to have baptized more than 300,000 and is patron of missionary work among blacks.

With any luck, summer delights will continue a while past last weekend's Labor Day: refreshing recreation (with maybe an occasional swim) or enjoyable relaxation on the deck (with tasty outdoor grilling). Truth is, for some of us, this year's Labor Day came way too early. With many schools back in session for a while already, mealtimes and driving schedules needed readjustment to coordinate youth sports with adult commitments. Some religious education and parish programs resumed, too. No surprise, then, that this weekend's scriptures sound a little like post-summer challenges. For instance, Wisdom reminds us that believers in God can never be content with "timid deliberations" and "unsure plans." Jesus instructs "great crowds" traveling with him—including us—on three things necessary for all true disciples to accomplish. On this early autumn weekend, our scriptures describe disciples' lifelong labors.



Children in 3rd grade and higher who are baptized and have received First Eucharist will continue their formation in age appropriate classes. It is the practice of our faith that formation is ongoing and is a life-long journey.

### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS):

This is a hands-on, interactive working environment where children are guided toward a greater understanding of God's love in their life. They encounter Jesus the Good Shepherd, who loves them, cares for them and knows them by name. Children are most sensitive to a relationship with God between the ages of 3-6. For this reason, we provide formal faith formation for young children.


