MERCY FLOWS, LOVE REDEEMS

Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

A QUARTER OF A CENTURY AGO

The day was May 8, 1999...last century! I had a sinus infection on that day when I was ordained to the Roman Catholic Priesthood of Jesus Christ! Twenty-five years seems so long ago, but it really has passed by rather quickly.

As I commemorate my Silver Jubilee of Priesthood this year, I've been thinking about how important the Holy Eucharist has been in my life beginning fifty-five years ago in 1969 when I received my First Holy Communion. Like every child receiving the Eucharist for the first time, I remember how special I felt. Now I could, like the adults, go to Mass and kneel at the communion rail (that's how everyone received the Eucharist those days) and actually receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus himself!

Ten years later in 1979, I would graduate from Providence Catholic High School in New Lenox, Illinois, and enter the formation program for the Conventual Franciscan Friars of St. Bonaventure Province in Chicago. Devotion to the Holy Eucharist and our Blessed Mother were pillars of our Province. The years following saw my First Profession of Religious Vows in 1982 (the same day I turned 21 on July 15th!) followed by Solemn Vows in 1985. Known as Brother Jim in those years, I served in various clerical, formation, liturgical and musical ministries.

Twenty years later after high school, I was ordained a Conventual Franciscan Priest in 1999, and was now known as Father Jim. There was, and still is, nothing more important than being able to preside at Mass and administer the Sacraments. I served my first six years of priesthood as the Parochial Vicar at St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Rockford, Illinois, and then my next five years as Pastor and Rector of the Basilica of St. Josaphat in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Ten years after Priestly Ordination, in 2009, I began the formal process to eventually move to Las Vegas and discern if God wanted me to share my priesthood where there was, and still is, such a need for priests. In July of 2010, I began my first two years of ministry as the Parochial Vicar and then Temporary Parochial Administrator here at SEAS which helped me solidify the call from God to live out the rest of my priesthood as a diocesan priest in this great Archdiocese of Las Vegas! The fact that SEAS has a special Mater Dei Eucharistic Adoration Chapel was an added bonus to help me in my discernment.

In July of 2012, I was assigned as the Parochial Administrator of St. John Neumann (SJN) in North Las Vegas, and then appointed Pastor of SJN in 2013 when I was formally incardinated as a priest of the then Diocese of Las Vegas. With my incardination, my religious vows expired and I was no longer a member of the Conventual Franciscan Friars. My last three years as Pastor of SJN I was also assigned as Pastor of St. James the Apostle which added to my ministry and joy!

2019 saw my return to SEAS as the Pastor, a blessing and privilege I thought would never be possible. I also count it an honor to celebrate my Silver Jubilee year where my ministry in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas first began.

SAVE THE DATE!

And so, I would count it a real blessing if you could "save the date" and join me in a *Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving commemorating my Silver Jubilee of Priesthood.* This Mass will take place on *Friday*, *September 20th at 5:30 PM* followed by a delicious reception of what I call "Festival Food" on our parish campus. Members of my family and friends from the Midwest and my prior parishes hope to join me as well. I'd love for you to meet them and for them to meet you!

You know, I've spent the majority, fourteen, of my twenty-five years of priesthood here in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas and half of my Vegas years here at SEAS. God has been so good to me through our Bishops (our Emeritus Bishop Pepe who welcomed me to Las Vegas, Archbishop Thomas who entrusted me with this fine parish and some other ministries of the Archdiocese, and remains so supportive of me, and Bishop Gordon who has been so encouraging and supportive as well), my brother Priests and Deacons, and dear Sisters, along with those of you, parishioners and friends of SEAS alike, who have supported my priesthood and ministry among you. And last, but certainly not least, I have been blessed with an amazing Parish Staff and Parish School Administration, Staff and Faculty. All of us, who remain connected to "The Vine" and supportive of each other, continue to bear much fruit as we are nourished through the Holy Eucharist and "journey together joyfully!" Thank you for making it all worthwhile!

EXAMPLES OF OUR FAITH



St. Cyril of Jerusalem

St. Cyril of Jerusalem (c.315-386) was born and raised in Jerusalem. He was educated in the faith and at an early age had a love of Scripture that guided him toward the priesthood.

After he was ordained a priest by the Bishop of Jerusalem, he went on to serve as a catechist for those newly baptized in his congregations. The writings he produced during the early years of his priesthood have gone on to help give the modern Church a clear example of how the Church of the East did things during those first few centuries of Christianity. Included were teachings on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, prerequisites for Baptism, the Eucharistic liturgy, and more.

During the fourth century, the Arian heresy, which denied the divinity of Christ, was threatening to tear the young Church apart. It was during this time that Cyril was ordained Bishop of Jerusalem and accused by his contemporaries of Arianism. They exiled him from his homeland on three different occasions, but he was ultimately acquitted of the accusations both in his own time and a thousand years later when he was named a Doctor of the Church in 1822.

Once back in Jerusalem, he and a bishop named Gregory, who would become St. Gregory, attended the Council of Constantinople, where the Nicene Creed was officially adopted. During this time, he publicly accepted and promoted the word "consubstantial," the word the Council of Nicaea chose to describe Christ's divinity and the relationship between God the Father and the Son.

His life reminds us that even a prominent theologian of the Church can suffer pain from controversy. Despite this, he never gave up and went on to be recognized as a Doctor of the Church. St. Cyril, pray for us!

6th Sunday of Easter

Once a man came to the Vatican and asked to see Pope John Paul II, claiming that they had been friends in Poland. When told of the man, the Pope said, "He is mistaken about our friendship. I don't recall ever having suffered with him." As it turned out, the man had never known the Pope. Now, I'm not sure if the story is totally factual. But doesn't the juxtaposition of suffering with friendship sound exactly like JPII? He understood that the deepest and most lasting friendships are forged in the fires of shared suffering. No suffering, no friendship. Amazing.

This week we hear Jesus say to the apostles and to us, "You are my friends if you do what I command you" (John 15:14). In Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, God entered the world of human suffering and transformed it into an avenue of friendship with Himself. Following His command — to love, to lay down our lives for others — will always entail suffering. But this suffering only deepens our friendship with Him. His suffering is ours; ours is His. We have become friends of God.

This week, how might you share your suffering with the Risen Jesus? How might he be sharing his suffering with you, in the lives of those around you? Be attentive to that, and you'll find that you are indeed a friend of God, because you've suffered together a great deal.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Question: My neighbor is just beginning to explore the Catholic faith but was raised agnostic. I grew up believing in God, praying, and attending Mass. How does one start from scratch as an adult to develop a relationship with God?

Answer: Start on a personal level! How did you and your neighbor become friends? How did you begin to discuss such a personal topic as faith? Communication, spending time together, and getting to know each other are essential to forming the bonds of a relationship. Personal prayer is essential to our relationship with God. We can't be close to someone we don't know! Invite your friend to explore the stories of Jesus in the Bible. Introduce them to the lives of the saints, especially ones you think they might be interested in.

Your neighbor might also have questions about the Catholic faith that you don't know how to answer. If your friend hasn't yet enrolled in RCIA classes, invite them to Mass at your parish. Introduce your friend to the faith formation director to make a connection. Personal support can be helpful as well, especially if few of your neighbor's current friends are practicing their faith. Connect your neighbor to other people in your parish living their faith well. The good examples of other faithful people could help your neighbor to feel welcomed and supported. Our Church is vibrant and alive!

Gospel: Jesus taught his disciples that loving him and loving each other brings "complete joy." What brings you joy in your life?


