In our Profession of Faith during a Eucharistic Celebration, we recite the Creed. Part of the Creed, referring to Jesus, states: "He suffered under Pontius Pilot, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again." Praying the Stations of the Cross is a way of slowing down those lines from our Creed, and journeying with Jesus during his last hours of human life and through to the amazing Easter morning of His resurrection.
