What is Vacation Bible School?

Vacation Bible School is a fun Scripture learning experience where youth gain valuable tools to use everyday. Young people are able to learn leadership skills, responsibility, and team work.

It is important to remember that as a member of the Vacation Bible School team you are not only representing yourself, but also St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Roman Catholic Church, the Diocese of Las Vegas, and most importantly, Jesus Christ. Vacation Bible School team members are expected to live their faith and be a positive example to others of what it means to be a Catholic.

Application for Team Members

The process for applying to serve on the Vacation Bible School team begins with completing this application. The application will then be carefully read by the Youth Ministry Office and ALL <u>new applicants ARE RESPONSIBLE</u> for scheduling an interview with Meghan Hernandez through the Sign Up Genius link emailed to you after the Youth Ministry Office receives your application. After the completion of the interview process the information will be reviewed by the Youth Ministry Staff and the applicants will be notified of our decision. Please note, service as a team member one year does not guarantee acceptance from year to year.

Who May Apply?

Any youth entering grades 7—12 in the Fall of 2017 as well as college students and adults. Parents we need your help too!

Please note: VBS Team Member Applications must be returned to the Youth Ministry Office no later than Thursday, May 4, 2017.

Commitment, Dedication and Selection Process

Vacation Bible School team members must be committed. Team members are responsible for the week(s) they are assigned plus 2 hours of decoration. A team member may sign up to decorate more than the two hours if they wish. Team members must be committed to the entire week they are assigned. Unfortunately, we cannot allow team members to volunteer only some days during a week as it is disruptive to the youth attending. Do not schedule any doctor, dentist, orthodontist appointments, personal appointments, etc. before 1:30 p.m. on the week you are volunteering at VBS. Additionally, although you may sign up to volunteer one particular week, you may be assigned to volunteer a different week.

Priority will be given to active, participating members of Youth Ministry programs and parish ministries as well as returning team members. Assignments will be made based on the number of years volunteered at Vacation Bible School, and parish/Youth Ministry involvement, not the age of the leader. Please note, active/participating members of Youth Ministry programs will receive the highest scheduling priority. Scheduling of volunteers will be done at the discretion of the Youth Ministry Staff.

Some of the time commitments of team members include:

- Arrival at 7:45 a.m. each day
- Dismissal at 1:15 p.m. each day
- Attendance at the Vacation Bible School Team Meeting and Retreat on Saturday, June 3rd from 1:00 p.m. —5:00 p.m. (Attendance is mandatory)
- Movie Tuesday afternoons from 1:15 p.m.—4:00 p.m.

You will lead the youth through the daily activities in your room each time a new cycle of crews comes in.

Vacation Bible School Core Team Questionnaire

Would you like to be a part of the VBS Core Team? VBS Core Team is open to youth entering grades 9—12 as well as college students and adults in the Fall of 2017. VBS Core Team applicants must commit to the following meetings/events:

Meeting #1: Saturday, May 6th from 9-10 a.m. for Week 1 & 10-11 a.m. for Week 2 Meeting #2: Saturday, May 20th from 9-11 a.m. for Week 1 & 2 Meeting #3: Thursday, June 1st from 6-8 p.m. for Week 1 & 2

Other meetings may be scheduled depending on the need and schedules of the Core Team Members.

Assist in planning and implementation of VBS Team Member Retreat on Saturday, June 3rd, from 1:00 p.m.—5:00 p.m.

Core Team Members must volunteer their full week of Vacation Bible School and assist in decorating the week before. Core Team Members are responsible for the design and decoration of their room. Core Team Members do not have to volunteer for both weeks of VBS.

Vacation Bible School Room Descriptions

- 1. **Games**: Where the youth come to have a great time with energetic games. There will be 1 or 2 "water game" days where you will be outside in the Courtyard for the day. The other location for the games will be in the Cafeteria. You will be responsible for setting up the games, explaining the games to the youth and helping to clean up the room.
- 2. **Snacks**: This room is for the youth to come, sit down, and enjoy a nice snack. The "menu" is set before the week begins. You will be responsible for setting up and cleaning up throughout the day, reminding the crew leaders to do their God Sightings or leading the youth through a game if all are finished eating from the VBS approved game list.
- 3. **Bible Adventure**: This room is where the story of the week is told. Choosing this room requires dressing up as a character, acting out stories if need be, and encouraging and helping the youth to do the activity that comes along with each day.
- 4. Imagination Station (usually only one week of VBS) This room is full of imagination! Youth come into this room to be amazed by small science experiments or activities related to the day's theme. Choosing this room sometimes means getting messy!
- 5. **Crafts** (sometimes 2 crafts stations during the week of VBS): The crafts room(s) are responsible for making the crafts of the day. This requires setting up and cleaning up throughout the day, as well as helping the youth make the craft if necessary (particularly the younger youth).
- 6. **Music Melodies**: As we know the big finale on Friday works best when the youth know the songs and motions. Music Melodies is a second teaching opportunity for the youth. You will be required to be familiar with the songs and the motions and be willing to teach them to the youth and youth leaders. Lots of smiles are required to make the room fun and energetic!

Vacation Bible School Guidelines

Team Members

- All Vacation Bible School team members are expected to act in a Christ-like manner at all times towards everyone in the program including your peers. This includes:
 - ♣ No inappropriate language
 - no roughhousing or "play-fighting"
 - * Keeping your hands to yourself at all times
 - no teasing or ridiculing anyone
 - Any other behaviors deemed inappropriate by the Youth Ministry Office
 - Inappropriate behavior may result in your removal from the Vacation Bible School team.
 - Appropriate and modest dress is required. We will provide you with a Vacation Bible School T-shirt which must be worn at all times. Please make sure your t-shirts are clean and presentable. T-shirts do not have to be tucked in. However, t-shirts may not be tied in the back with a rubber band or any other item. Jeans and shorts are permitted, but they must be of a modest length. No skirts are permitted at VBS. Only natural hair coloring is allowed during VBS weeks.
 - ❖ No sandals, flip-flops, or open-toed shoes. Tennis shoes or flats are required.
 - Please remember that at all times you are representing St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church, the Diocese of Las Vegas, and most importantly, Jesus Christ.

- Parents will discuss these guidelines with their child and reinforce the necessity of proper Catholic Christian behavior at all times.
