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MERCY FLOWS, LOVE REDEEMS

Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

NOW YOU SEE HIM!

This past Wednesday gave us the opportunity to witness the “soft revealing” of our statue of St. Carlo Acutis at the foot of the Crucified Christ. The occasion which prompted this “soft revealing” was the monthly rosary gathering of the Las Vegas Area of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem, which was scheduled here at SEAS on September 9th, 2026. The Equestrian Order is an ancient Order of the Roman Catholic Church that helps support the care of the empty tomb of Jesus (the Holy Sepulcher) in Jerusalem. In addition, the Order supports many good works in the Holy Land. Their website describes them as “a Catholic order of chivalry commissioned to support the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem and the Christian presence in the Holy Land.” Please visit their website for more information:

I am honored to be a member of this Order and inspired by the faith and generosity of its members, especially our “locals”! SOME CONCLUSIONS FROM MY RECENT MAYO CLINIC VISIT

This past week I finally had two meetings to put my recent visit to Mayo Clinic in Phoenix in some perspective for the near future.

On Tuesday, September 8th (the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary) I received a call from Dr. Sanford giving me the collective advice from the team of doctors who discussed my case with the neuroendocrine tumor located in my pancreas. Basically, they are all in agreement that I will not have the surgical “Whipple” procedure to remove the tumor because, in my case, the expected complications from the surgery are too many to make this a viable option. But, since this is such a rare and slow-growing

cancer, they all agree that we should just monitor the tumor for six months without the need for any other treatment options at this time. I’ll be returning to Mayo in Phoenix sometimes in March of 2027 for a ct-scan and meeting with an oncologist as well. At this time we will re-evaluate my situation. If any symptoms arise before that time, we will address those immediately.

In reference to the nodule found in the left lobe of my thyroid gland from the PET scan I recently had done at Mayo on August 24th, the results of the biopsy were that the nodule was benign. On Wednesday, September 9th (the memorial of St. Peter Claver), I had a ZOOM call with Dr. Cronin to discuss continuing to watch the nodule since it is so small at this time. Through some blood work and an exam in 6 months we will continue to monitor that situation as well.

In essence, this is all “good” news for the time being. The neuroendocrine tumor in the pancreas will eventually need further attention and there’s no way to determine any length of time before that will be necessary. Likewise, the nodule in the thyroid has a chance to develop into something more serious, but, for now, I’m grateful that it just needs to be monitored.

You’re continued prayers and support are helping me wade through the waters of this new stage in my life. There is no doubt in my mind that our good Lord continues to journey with me and will continue to do so, and you are proof of that as well! Thanks for accompanying me!

VIRTUES EXPLAINED

Friendliness, *Explained*

The modern world we all must share seems, in some ways, to be shrinking.

For good or ill, thanks to the internet, the widespread use of social media, and the omnipresence of smartphones, we are finding ourselves interacting frequently with people who live, act, and think differently than we do. It may well be that the virtue of friendliness, known officially as affability, is more important than ever.

In fact, being attached as it is to the virtue of justice, friendliness is a debt we owe our fellow human beings, writes St. Thomas Aquinas (Sum., II:II, 114, Art. 2). The fact is, we cannot evangelize without kindness. We can see this in the instructions Christ gives his disciples in the Gospel of Matthew: "As you enter a house, wish it peace. If the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it; if not, let your peace return to you." (Matthew 10:13)

WORSHIP & MEDITATION

LITURGY GOSPEL MEDITATIONS

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time — Matthew 18:21-35

In my parish, there was once a new employee who frequently told me she was sorry for various imperfections in her work. It could be a little tiring. I finally told her, "You know, you don't have to say 'sorry' so often." She looked me right in the eyes and said, "Father, you're right. I'm sorry." Her ear-to-ear grin betrayed that she enjoyed the irony — and that she would keep asking for forgiveness as often as she needed it.

The Gospel reading this week proclaims to us that God, in Jesus, delights in numerous requests for, and the granting of, forgiveness. To Peter's question, **"Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?"** Jesus responds, **"I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times."** In other words, Peter, stop counting.

Christian life should be marked by a commitment to frequent forgiveness. God never tires of forgiving us. His limitless love has overcome the power of vengeance, hatred, and division. We tap into that each and every time we ask for forgiveness or extend it to another.

How beautiful our hearts become when they become accustomed to frequent forgiveness! How joyful and attractive become our marriages, families, and parish communities! How light our souls feel when unburdened by the habit of keeping score.

Challenge: Name one thing, small or large, for which you could ask forgiveness from someone in your life. Then do it.

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WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: Why can't everyone who wants to receive Communion, receive Communion at Mass?

Answer: Outside of the Church, many organizations have all sorts of requirements for membership: dues, achievements, professional standings, etc. The requirements bring the group together in common purposes and goals. Within the Church, there are also basic "requirements" for receiving the sacraments. As Catholics, we believe that the Eucharist is the true "Bread of Life." It is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. When we receive the Eucharist, we are receiving Jesus. Out of reverence for Christ, only those in union with this teaching and in a state of grace should receive communion. As Catholics, we should abstain from communion if we are in mortal sin.

While we share many articles of faith with our Protestant brothers and sisters, their understanding of this teaching is fundamentally different. For most non-Catholic churches, they do not believe that Christ becomes truly present in the Eucharist. As such, they should not receive communion in a Catholic Church. These differences are greater for people of non-Christian faiths, and even more apparent for those who do not believe in God. Receiving communion is not a right, but a gift to be accepted in humble, trusting faith.

Mercy You Can Feel

"You qualify for forgiveness," I heard the woman on the other end of the phone tell me, and I surprised myself by starting to weep. I had called the hospital system's financial services department to set up a payment plan on a balance I owed after having some unexpected scans and tests. I was hoping to minimize the dent our family's savings took — transform one devastating wallop into a series of more easily absorbed blows, so to speak.

Imagine my surprise when I realized the hospital was pulling its punch. If you have ever had a financial debt forgiven, you know the relief that came over me in that moment. It wasn't until a little later that the guilt set in. I know so many people who have medical debt. Why was I able to get out of paying, and they were not?

But the cold, hard truth is that I didn't "get out" of anything. My insurance, for which I pay, had given the hospital enough money to cover the true cost of the procedures. That balance would merely have increased the hospital's profit. Make no mistake: capitalism does not forgive.

If you describe the Sacrament of Reconciliation to someone unfamiliar with theology, chances are they'll think God is a chump. "You get to go in, say you're sorry, and leave — and everything's just fine?" someone once asked me in disbelief. Well, yeah. That's forgiveness.

Real mercy cannot be budgeted. It must be given recklessly, extravagantly, against all reason. It must cost the giver. It must scandalize any accountant worth his salt. And no one "qualifies."

If I can't wrap my head around the idea, it might mean I'm stuck in a for-profit paradigm of justice. It might just mean that I need to engage more in real mercy. Mercy I can feel.

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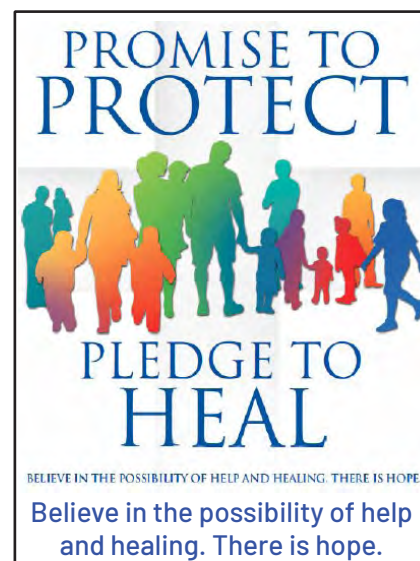
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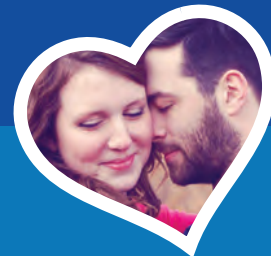
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
